## Course Description: 2 laps of the A1307 serving the Cambridge Crematorium north of Madingley

START (Grid Ref [TL4049361957](#)) at the 12<sup>th</sup> drain west of The Avenue, immediately before the Shared Use sign. Proceed west to: -

TURN (1 mile) at roundabout (RAB). Retrace towards start and continue to: -

TURN (2.2 miles) at RAB. Retrace towards start to complete first circuit. Repeat for 2<sup>nd</sup> circuit to: -

FINISH (Grid Ref [TL4063361816](#)) at the 7<sup>th</sup> drain east of The Avenue. Course map: - <https://ridewithgps.com/routes/31122664>

## Notes

- **Size of Warning Signs** (where specified) relates to the overall dimensions. Where not specified then a SMALL sign (24" x 19") or larger, may be used. MEDIUM sign (36" x 24")  
Rectangular KICKSTAND signs to be used at the START
- **All Marshals, and officials at start and finish should be supplied with and wear high visibility jackets.**  
All warning signs should be placed at least 50 yards before the relevant hazard. Marshals are specified where we consider there is a safety requirement and where necessary to indicate the route. It is the organiser's responsibility to post additional marshals where thought desirable.
- The small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garage, commercial premises, eatery, etc) that are not identified in this risk assessment have been considered and are considered not to pose a significant risk.

5	TURN at RAB east of start	Competitors negotiating RAB	Medium	MEDIUM Cycle Event Warning Sign prior to RAB on road not used by event route. 8	After finish	Competitors returning to congregation area	Medium	Instructions in Start Sheet and competitors briefing that there is to be NO STOPPING at finish. Competitors to turn left to wind down in The Avenue.
